He helped Metelica develop his psychic abilities, but they eventually had a falling out, along with others from the community, in the late 1970s. Babbitt ultimately established a non-profit, alternative school, the Opie Mountain Citadel, which was essentially run out of Babbitt's home in Northfield. He continued to involve himself in spiritual groups up to his failing health and eventual death in the Veteran's Administration Hospital in White River Junction, Vermont on April 25, 2001
