Scope of collection

In addition to an incomplete series of newsletters, the collection also includes a small number of books and pamphlets once owned within the meeting.

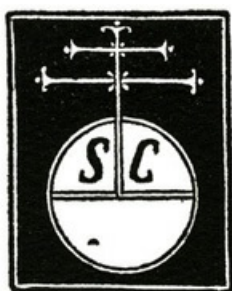
